<u>SPECIAL RULES</u>		
1. The 10 hr. On Period is available in <u>either</u> of two options: Option 1 - 10 p.m. to 8 a.m., Monday through Friday, and all day Saturday, Sunday and holidays. Option 2 - 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Monday through Friday, and all day Saturday, Sunday and holidays. The days of the year which are considered holidays are New Year's Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Friday After Thanksgiving, Day Before Christmas, Christmas Day, and Day Before New Year's Day.		
2. Service rendered under this schedule shall be metered through a separate meter. The electricity supplied under this schedule shall be electrically disconnected during the periods specified by the company and the time regulating device will be installed by the company and shall be under the sole control of the company. The time regulating device will be adjusted by the company to disconnect the electrical supply during 14 hours out of each daily period.

In emergency situations, the company will temporarily allow these facilities to operate during the normal off hours. This operation shall only be permitted for the length of the emergency. The determination of what constitutes an emergency shall be determined by the company, and the meter alteration required shall be performed by the company and the costs billed to the customer.

The customer shall furnish, install, and wire the necessary service entrance equipment, meter sockets, meter enclosure cabinets, meter connection cabinets, and circuits required to properly meter the energy supplied under this schedule through a company-owned meter. All circuits between the meter and the customer's equipment or units shall be enclosed in metal conduit or in an approved flexible metallic cable with no service outlets or branch circuits either in the circuits or on the customer's equipment or units.

- R 3. Only permanently installed equipment shall be permitted under this schedule. Equipment with individual elements that collectively have a wattage exceeding 6,000 watts shall be energized in sequence at time intervals of not less than three seconds between each start and shutdown for each 6,000 watts or less increment.
- R 4. All systems installed under this schedule shall be approved by the company in advance of installation and shall be specifically described in a contract entered into between the company and the customer. Applicants will be honored on a first-come, first-serve basis in accordance with the date of execution of the contract between the customer and the company.
- R 5. The company agrees to keep this schedule, or a similar schedule, available to customers who execute contracts for a minimum of 10 years.
- R 6. Electric water heating, in conjunction with the space heating and/or space cooling requirements, may receive service under this schedule. In this case, the water heating load is subject to all requirements of this schedule.
