WPS Offers Two Important Safety Programs:

Electric Safety – Path-to-Ground

The **Electric Safety – Path-to-Ground** program deals with the potential hazards of overhead and underground electric lines. Demonstrations include a 15,000-volt, path-to-ground display board and the safety equipment needed for line electricians to work on primary power lines. The three important safety messages students will learn are:

- Always respect electricity.
- Assume all downed power lines are live and dangerous.
- Never become a path-to-ground.

Natural Gas Safety & You

The **Natural Gas Safety & You** program uses a variety of visual demonstrations showing the properties of natural gas. Demonstrations include the use of a large pop tube, natural gas operated radio and gas lamps. The four important safety messages students will learn are:

- Natural gas is safe if used properly.
- You should know and respect the dangers of carbon monoxide.
- Natural gas appliances need to be checked annually by a professional.
- If you smell gas, call WPS immediately.

Each program takes approximately 35 minutes with time at the end for questions and answers. Students will receive activity booklets with each program to help reinforce the safety messages in the presentations.

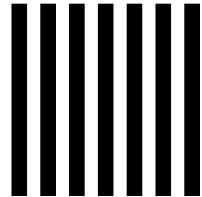
